# County of Ventura 2009 Employment Survey

for Homeless Persons

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This report was prepared for the Ventura County Homeless and Housing Coalition

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# I. Executive Summary

The County of Ventura 2009 Employment Survey for Homeless Persons was implemented in order to obtain information from the county's homeless population concerning employment and income. The County of Ventura 2009 Employment Survey was administered on the streets and in shelter programs. Surveyors targeted 20% of the homeless population in each jurisdiction according to the January 2009 Homeless Count. More than 300 (309) homeless persons who were living on the county's streets were asked questions about their current and past employment and income history. These persons represent approximately 15% of the number of homeless persons who live on the county's streets on a day like today according the County of Ventura 2009 Homeless Count.

Of the 309 persons who were surveyed nearly three out of four (74%) were men and one out of four (26%) were women and over half were White (58%) and nearly one-third (29%) were Hispanic/Latino. The majority of survey respondents (51%) were between the ages of 30 – 49–22% were between the ages of 30-39 and 29% were between 40-49.

## Key Findings

This report is divided into two sections. The first section concerns those survey respondents who stated that they were employed and the second section concerned those who stated that they were unemployed.

Key findings concerning those survey respondents who stated that they were employed included:

- A. Approximately half stated that they worked full-time (47%) and half part-time (53%);
- B. nearly one of four (22%) stated that they have more than one job;
- C. Nearly half (46%) stated that they worked as laborers (26%) or in food service (20%);
- D. More than three out of four (78%) stated that they were currently working in Ventura County;
- E. Over half (51%) stated that they were currently working in the City of Ventura;
- F. Approximately one-third (35%) stated that they had a monthly income of over \$1,000, 33% stated between \$501-\$1,000, and one-fourth (25%) stated between \$1-\$300.

Key findings concerning those survey respondents who stated that they were unemployed included:

- A. A large majority (94%) of survey respondents stated that they had been employed before;
- B. More than three-fourths (76%) stated that they had worked in Ventura County;
- C. Approximately two-thirds (66%) were previously employed in either Oxnard or Ventura—38% in Ventura and 28% in Oxnard;
- D. Nearly two-thirds (63%) of survey respondents did not have a temporary or permanent disability that prevented them from working; however, more than one-fourth (26%) did have a permanent disability and 11% had a temporary disability that prevented them from working;
- E. Nearly two-thirds (64%) were employed within the last couple of years—nearly half (48%) within the last year;
- F. Nearly half (45%) stated that the reason that they left their job was because they were laid off or because of disability or injury—more than one-fourth (28%) stated because they were laid off and nearly one of five (17%) stated due to disability or injury;
- G. Two-thirds (66%) stated that they were currently seeking work;
- H. More than half (58%) stated that they need assistance in finding a job;
- I. Approximately two-thirds (64%) stated that they had no income.

# II. Introduction

# A. Purpose

The County of Ventura 2009 Employment Survey for Homeless Persons was implemented in order to obtain information from the county's homeless population concerning employment and income.

#### B. Place

The County of Ventura 2009 Employment Survey was administered on the streets and in shelter programs. Surveyors targeted 20% of the homeless population in each jurisdiction according to the January 2009 Homeless Count.

# C. Participants

More than 300 (309) homeless persons who were living on the county's streets were asked questions about their current and past employment and income history. These persons represent approximately 15% of the number of homeless persons who live on the county's streets on a day like today according the County of Ventura 2009 Homeless Count.

Of the 309 persons who were surveyed, nearly three out of four (74%) were men and one out of four (26%) were women.
